YOU WILL FLY INTO FORT NELSON, BC AND WE WILL PICK YOU UP AND BRING YOU BACK TO THE LODGE. FROM THE LODGE YOU WILL EITHER HORSEBACK, FLY OR BACKPACK TO YOUR FINAL HUNTING DESTINATION. THE MAIN LODGE IS EQUIPPED WITH SATELLITE TV, INTERNET AND A POOL TABLE. WHEN THE HUNT IS DONE WE WILL TRANSPORT YOU BACK TO FORT NELSON. ACCOMMODATIONS DURING THE HUNT WILL BE CABIN, WALL TENT OR BACKPACK TENT, DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF HUNT. ALL FOOD IS PROVIDED FOR THE ENTIRE TIME AS SOON AS YOU ARRIVE AT THE LODGE. IT WILL BE ONE ON ONE GUIDING UNLESS A SPECIAL TWO-ON -ONE TRIP IS BOOKED.

YOU CAN ALSO DRIVE IF YOU WOULD LIKE A MORE SCENIC TOUR OF BC. WE ARE LOCATED ON MILE 419 ALASKA HIGHWAY AND THERE IS PAVED HIGHWAY RIGHT TO THE LODGE. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO BRING YOUR MEAT BACK HOME WITH YOU, WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU BRING A COOLER OR SMALL FRIDGE THAT CAN PLUG IN TO YOUR TRUCK.
